## Parathyroid Scan

Appointment: Date and Time:,, 20 at AM PM
Parking Park in the Visitor parking lot and enter through our hospital main entrance.
Registration: Please check-in with our Admitting department in the main lobby of the hospital.
<b>What information will this give my doctor?</b> This test will show the location of the parathyroid glands and how they are working.
What do I need to know before I get there? There is no special preparation for this study.
How long will it take? Generally, this test takes about 2.5 hours. When you arrive in the Nuclear Medicine department, a technologist will give you an injection of a radioactive tracer. This tracer does not have any side effects. You will be placed under one of our cameras that will take a series of pictures lasting approximately 40 minutes. Following this you will have a break for approximately 1 hour before you return to the Nuclear Medicine department. Upon your return, another picture will be taken. This lasts approximately 10 minutes.
