

Requesting Access to Your MyStLukes Portal Account

Requesting Access

- 1.** Request access through one of the following. *Note:* a valid email address must be provided when requesting access:
 - Download and print the Patient Enrollment Form from [this link](#) and mail or fax according to the form.
 - OR -
 - Visit a participating St. Luke's Medical Group physician office and request enrollment.
 - OR -
 - Visit the St. Luke's Hospital or St. Luke's Des Peres Hospital patient registration area and request enrollment.
- 2.** When your application is received, you will be sent an email invitation valid for 90 days with instructions to login to the MyStLukes patient portal.
- 3.** Each MyStLukes portal account requires a unique email address. If you share an email address with spouse or other family member or need to gain access to a family member's account, permission will need to be granted through one of the following:
 - Download and print the Proxy Authorization Form from [this LINK](#).
 - Request proxy access at the physician's office.
 - *Note:* Any patient age 13 or older will provide consent for another family member to share access.

Self-Enrollment

If you are over the age of 18 and your email address has previously been provided to us and is stored in our system, or if you have a medical record number (MRN) from our new electronic medical record (EMR) system (after 10/01/2018), you can self-enroll from [this LINK](#).
