The Only St. Louis Hospital To Earn The Top Rating for Heart Bypass Procedures

We are the only St. Louis hospital to earn the top three-star rating from The Society of Thoracic Surgeons (STS) for its patient care and outcomes in isolated coronary artery bypass grafting (CABG) procedures. The three out of three-star rating, which denotes the highest category of quality, places St. Luke's Hospital among the elite for heart bypass surgery in the United States and Canada.

TAVR - An Innovative Option for High-Risk Heart Patients

We are one of the top-performing Transcatheter Aortic Valve Replacement (TAVR) facilities in St. Louis. Like valve surgery, TAVR places a new aortic valve but does so without the need for open-heart surgery. St. Luke's also has a 0 percent mortality rate in the hospital and has one of the safest TAVR track records in St. Louis.

MRI Scans for Non-MRI Conditional Pacemakers and ICDs

St. Luke's Hospital is the exclusive adult-only hospital in the St. Louis area offering a protocol to scan Non-MRI conditional pacemakers and Implantable Cardioverter Defibrillators (ICDs). This offering allows patients who have pacemaker devices and/or internal defibrillators (who previously were not able to have MRI scans) to now have this procedure at St. Luke's Hospital. Most MRI facilities in the area choose not to perform these exams on patients with pacemakers and ICDs.

Among the Lowest Readmissions in the Region

St. Luke's continues to be a leader in preventing readmissions, as evidenced by our 30-day readmission rate of Medicare Coronary Artery Bypass Graft (CABG) patients being significantly better (lower) than the regional rate.
